She played with the Kansas City Youth Symphony at the New York World's Fair on Missouri Day, and was the first Principal horn with the Saint Louis Symphony Youth Orchestra.

She spent 8 years as a member of the horn section of the Saint Louis Symphony Orchestra and has been the principal horn at the Muny since 1975. Other music jobs of note have been tours with Phantom of the Opera, Les Miz and Lion King.

A native of Kansas City, she graduated from Shawnee Mission East High School in Prairie Village, Kansas.

Ms. Schick has studied with Roland Pandolfi, Carl Schiebler, Kaid Friedel, John Barrows, Douglas Hill and Dale Clevenger.
