Tom Vincent

Tom Vincent grew up in suburban Chicago, where he studied trombone with James Gilbertsen of the Chicago Symphony Orchestra. He received his Bachelor's degree *magna cum laude* in Music Education from the Lawrence University Conservatory of Music. He has also earned the Master of Science degree in Industrial Technology from Eastern Illinois University.

Tom enlisted in the U.S. Air Force in 1986 and remained a member of Air Force bands for 21 years, retiring in the rank of Master Sergeant in 2007. As a performer on trombone and euphonium for the Air Force, Tom was a founding member of the highly acclaimed *Four Star Brass* tuba-euphonium ensemble. He has premiered numerous works including the *Concerto for Euphonium* by Robert Jager and *To The Edge Of Space* by Sam Pilafian and Patrick Sheridan.

Mr. Vincent is an active freelance musician in the St. Louis area, where he has performed with artists such as Bob Hope, Johnny Mathis, Maynard Ferguson, Tito Puente, Jr., Manhattan Transfer, The Four Tops and The Temptations. He performs nationwide with The Fabulous Motown Revue, including the group's performance in Washington, DC for the Midwest Ball during President Obama's inauguration ceremonies.

Tom is a regular member of the Saint Louis Trombone Quartet (aka, The Boneheads) and serves on the board of directors for the Saint Louis Low Brass Collective. When not performing music, Tom is a data manager for Saint Louis University, where his daughter, Nia, is enrolled as a pre-med major.
