Made in 1930’s. Re-lacquered in 1971. Lacquer finish is in excellent condition. Slide lock has been removed. Inner slide stocking shows some wear. Serial #: 131534 Asking price: \$250.00

**“RMC Martin “Imperial” Tenor Intermediate Trombone”** – Official Music Man Model.  
7.5” bell and original case in excellent condition. Acquired around 1984. No dents – lacquer like new, except where left hand grips horn. Serial #: 213875 Asking price: Old \$350.00 Now \$325

**“OLDS Recording Professional Tenor Trombone** – 8” bell. Made in Fullerton, CA. in 1964. Re-lacquered in 1983. Lacquer is worn a few spots; slide, neck and where left hand grips the horn. This horn used on many professional engagements. Serial #: 378437 Comes with SKB hardshell case that is like new. Asking price: \$500.00

**SOLD “Schilke Professional Silver Trumpet with interchangeable bell section**– model B6L late 1970’s. Tiny dent in “harder” bell, softer bell was never used. Comes with gig bag. Serial #: 9256 Asking price: \$1100.00

**SOLD “C.G. Conn Ltd. Trumpet.** From 1940. The bell was made without the “wired” rim, like most trumpets have. No dents, lacquer finish in excellent condition. case in excellent condition. This horn was extremely well taken care of. Serial #: 337014 Asking price: \$300.00

**“Pagani Rotary Valve Cornet”** – Imported to New York, NY. I believe it’s from the early 1900’s. Inscribed on the bell is “Premiata Fabbrica Ferd Roth Milano Sistema Bottali”.

It has several dents and case is in good condition. Serial #: on the bar that holds rotary valves in place is “75”, and on the first valve casing is the #10.
